ANNUAL REPORT

ACADEMICS

“Education is the passport to the future for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare it today.” Academics is our top priority and no stone is left unturned to ensure quality education. Our result proves it. In the board exams of class X, 77 students appeared and all of them passed with flying colours. Km. Vaishnavi Bhustali was the school topper with 94.4% marks. In the science stream of class XII, 8 students appeared and all of them passed with good marks. Km. Spoorthi Patil was the Vidyalaya topper with 82.5% marks. The Vidyalaya received trophies from Kendriya vidyalaya regional office Bangalore for producing 100% result in board exams. In the internal exams 886 students appeared out of which 862 students passed and the overall result was 97.29%.

Co-Curricular Activities

The aim of education is all round development of the students. Co-curricular activities not only supplement the academics but also prepare the students for art of living.

We have well-designed system of CCA. The activities are conducted as per the schedule. There are five clubs named Eco club, readers club, Maths club, Science club and integrity clubs. All the students have been divided into four houses which are Ganga, Kaveri, Krishna and Yamuna.

Exhibitions and Olympiads

Social Science Exhibition: KVS plays a very crucial role in promoting national integration. In this direction, social science exhibition with the sub title ‘Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat’ is conducted every year. This year the students prepared projects, models, dance etc. on the Indian state Uttarakhand and the country USA. Cluster level exhibition was conducted at K.V. Sambra, Belgaum in which 56 students of our vidyalaya had participated. In Spell Bee our students Vinay Kalagi of X A and Zobia of VIII A bagged second position in senior and junior group respectively. In the creative writing in English second position was secured by Neha of VIII B. Siri of VIII A secured third position in shloka recitation

competition. Sneha of X B secured second position in solo singing. The group song and group dance both were given third positions.

NCSC & Olympiads:

To develop the scientific temperament among students, they were given chance to participate in National Children's Science Congress. Eight groups of our vidyalaya participated in NCSC held at KV IISc.

Master Samarth B of IX A participated in regional level math Olympiad.

Technothon exam was conducted by IIT Guwahati. 4 pairs of participants secured state rank 13, 8, 6 and 8. Students have participated in SOF and the green Olympiad and the result is awaiting.

Cubs and Bulbul & Bharat Scout and Guide:

The aim of education is to prepare the students to face difficulties, work in team and to develop social skills. To instill these qualities in the children, cubs and bulbul and scouts and guides activities are conducted on every Wednesday. There are three trained teachers. There are 69 cubs, 75 bulbuls, 85 scout and 73 guides in the vidyalaya. 8 scouts and 8 guides of our vidyalaya cleared Trtiya Sopan, 6 guides and 6 scouts cleared the Rajya Puraskar testing camp. 4 scouts and 4 guides have been registerd for Rashtrapati Awards.

Sports:

Here at KV we give the students ample opportunities to show case their talent in the field of sports. Under inter house competitions 22 events were conducted in four categories which are junior boya and junior girls, senior boys and senior girls. Sports Day was conducted on 6th November'18. Kaveri house won the first position and Yamuna house stood second. Under 19 hand ball team of girls consisting of 12 participants went to regional level. Bhavana D of IX A represented Bengaluru region in 49th National Sports Meet.

Celebrations of important days and weeks:

To apprise the students, the history of our great nation and make them understand the importance, certain events, important days and weeks are celebrated in the vidyalaya in the right spirit.

- International Yoga day was celebrated on 21st June.
- Investiture Ceremony: Today's students are tomorrow's leaders. We train the young students to be the dynamic, sincere and responsible leaders of tomorrow. The student leaders and council members were honoured with badges on 21st July 2018.
- Independence Day was celebrated in a grand way and was marked with plantation drive.
- **Sanskrit week:** Sanskrit is not only one of the most ancient languages of the world but also is the mother of most of the Indian languages. To apprise the students of its beauty and importance Sanskrit week was celebrated in the vidyalaya in a befitting manner.
- **Hindi Pakhwada:** Hindi is our national language which binds us all together. To promote Hindi, Hindi Pakhwada was observed from 1st to 14th September. Various competitions were conducted in Hindi. Renowned Hindi poet Prakash Singh Rajput was invited for guest lecture on the occasion.

The vidyalaya stood third among the 51 vidyalayas of Bangalore region and received swachh vidyalaya award on 30th January 2018. Under GSP Audit 2018, the vidyalaya procured orange certificate and this year also it is completed and better ranking is expected.

- **Bhasha Sangam:** Bhasha Sangam is being celebrated in the vidyalaya from 20th November to 21st December. The purpose is to give the students exposure to the linguistic diversity of our country and enable them to speak simple sentences in all the 22 languages scheduled in our constitution.
